

## PART IV – COMPETITION SQUAD



### **COMPETITION**

Varsity will be the only squad presented with the opportunity to participate in competition. The Advisor/Coaches and Administration will be the only ones to choose all competitions, uniforms, and competitors. This is not an area of negotiation.

1. It is **mandatory** that every member, including alternates, to attend all scheduled practices, choreography dates, and competitions.
2. It is **mandatory** that every member arrives on time and stay until the end of scheduled practices, choreography dates, and competitions.
3. It is **mandatory** that every member be fully dressed in the proper attire in order to fully participate. Forgetting your uniform is unacceptable....

If there are any discipline, responsibility, or behavioral issues, this may be the ground for either demotion or possible dismissal from the squad.



### **INJURIES**

If your student has had past injuries and/or medical issues, please make the advisor/coaches aware of the situation. The student should bring to every practice and competition the equipment needed in order to fully participate. This includes braces, inhalers, tape, etc.



### **FUNDRAISING**

There are many opportunities to raise money to help pay for the high cost such as candy sales, rummage sales, car washes, spirit days, sponsor letters, etc.

- Any scheduled competition fundraising is **mandatory**. The executive board will deem prior to the event whether the monies earned will be entered in a general account or individual competition squad members' accounts.



### **PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

Financial responsibilities include:

- Keeping regular squad and competition squad account current.
- Positively supporting your student during the season, regardless of the outcome
- Providing and/or arranging transportations to and from all competitions



### **FINANCIAL CONCERNS**

Deadlines will be set for financial costs. Many competitions require registration and/or deposits in advance. If a squad member's financial issues prohibit the squad from making registration deadlines, he/she may be removed from the routine and possibility from the squad.
